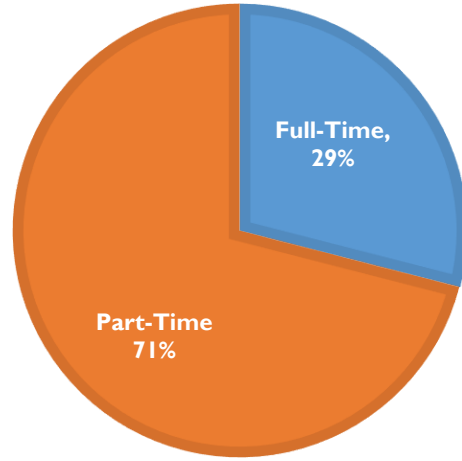

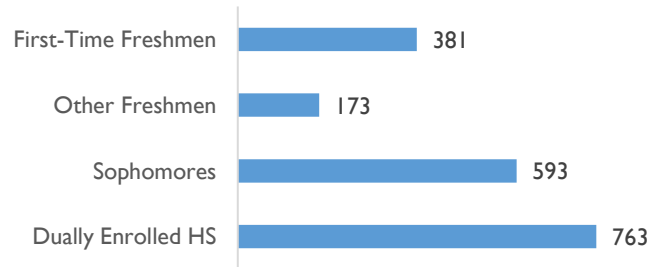
### ENROLLMENT STATUS



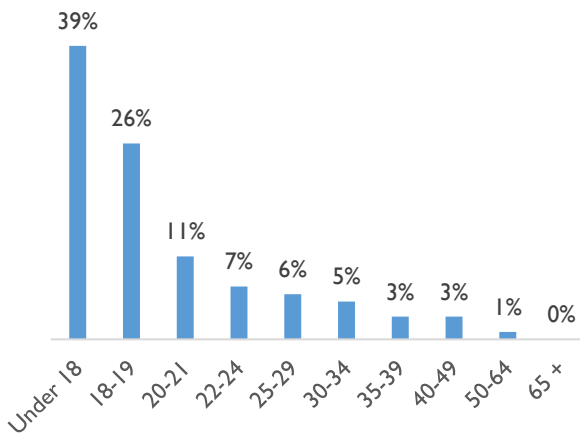

(98%)**



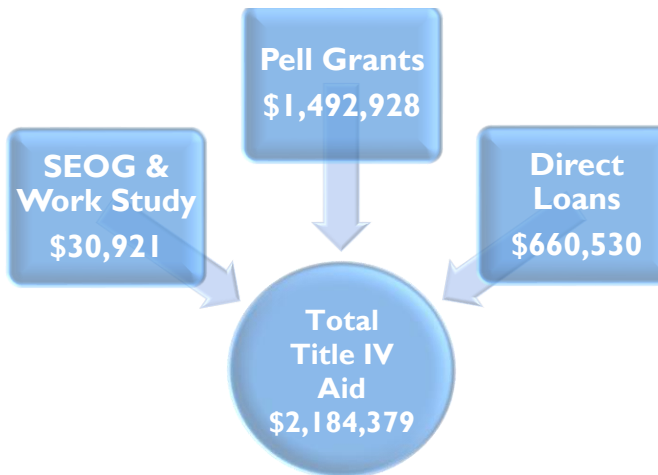

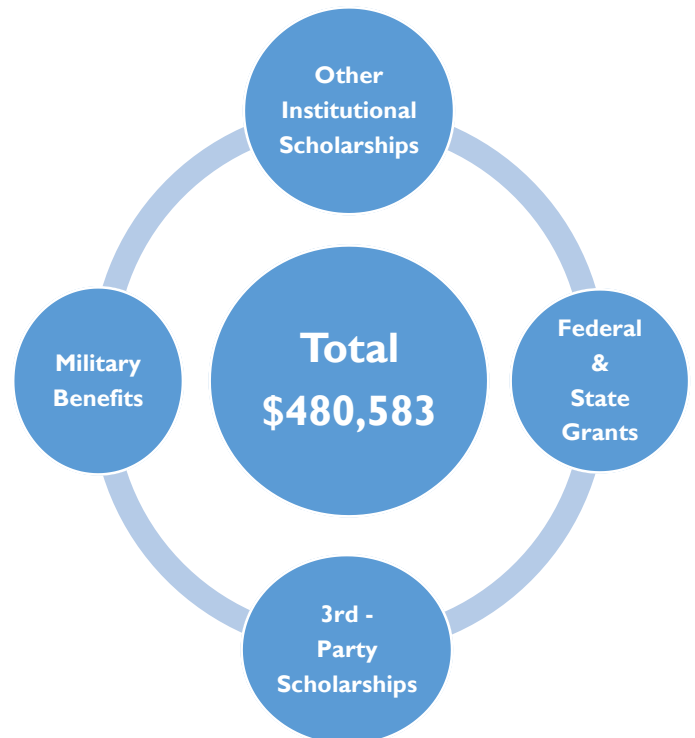
